(Southern Great Plains Eurotender Association for Youth, Culture, Education and Environment Protection)

The general meeting of Southern Great Plains Eurotender Association for Youth, Culture, Education and Environment Protection accepted the statutes of the Association on this day, taking the law on association (II/1989), the Civil Code of the Republic of Hungary (IV/1959) and the law on public benefit organisations (CLVI/1997) into consideration:

I.

General provisions

1.§

- 7.) *The Association is a legal entity and a public benefit organisation.*

The aim of the organisation

2.§

The aim of the organisation is to contribute to the success of the structural policy of the European Union in the Southern Great Plains region of Hungary, and to foster social and economic cohesion. Our operations include the support of disadvantaged people in the region, primarily improving the conditions of ethnicities, youth, old people, women and disabled people; preserving built and natural environment, and achieve sustainable development in harmony with the EU policies. In order to achieve these goals, we put great emphasis on cross-border cooperation and wide partnerships. With the mentioned activities, the association wishes to help social, economic and tourism development, and participate in the cultural life of the region.

3.§

The Association is independent of political parties, it does not conduct political activities, does not set up or support candidates on the parliamentary, local or minority government elections.

II.**Activities of the Association****4.§****The public benefit activities of the Association**

In order to achieve its goals, the Association conducts the following public benefit activities listed in point c of §26 of the law on public benefit organisations (1997):

- 18./ fostering the training and employment of disadvantaged people in the labour market, and connecting services*

- 20./ services provided by public benefit organisations for public benefit organisations.*

5.§

The public benefit services of the Association are available (either free of charge or for a charge depending on the service and the opportunities of the Association) for people who are not members of the Association as well.

Venture activities of the Association**6.§**
